In March, we celebrated the ribbon-cutting for the newly renovated track at historic Memorial Field. If you haven't visited yet, take advantage of these beautiful spring days and enjoy a lap or two!

You'll also notice street improvements happening soon. City Council awarded a contract for the resurfacing of TH Johnson Drive and West Lake Drive as well as the restriping of Bill Pickett Trail. Repairs will also be made to Second and Fourth streets.

As part of these road projects, crews will be removing the cycle track on Mallard Lane from Carlos G. Parker to North Drive. The first road work project will start by the summer and all projects are estimated to be completed by the end of the year.

Like the wildflowers blooming across the landscape, Taylor is thriving! I'm excited about the progress happening in our city and I hope you are too!

## Annual Report

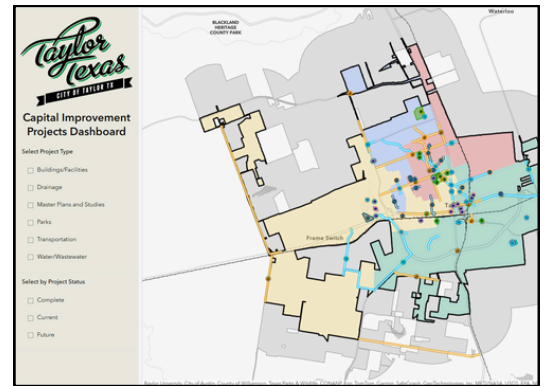
