## **Taylor Police Investigating Fatal Collision**

TAYLOR, Texas – Taylor Police are investigating a collision that resulted in the death of a man Monday morning in the 300 block of Carlos Parker Boulevard SW.

At 5:45 AM, Taylor Police received a call reporting the collision. The preliminary investigation revealed that a 2001 Honda driven by Dillon Patrick Coy, 24 years, of Bremond, Tx. was travelling westbound in the 300 block of Carlos Parker Boulevard SW when it veered off the roadway, struck a reflector pole on the right side of the roadway before over-correcting, veering left and then crossed the median into oncoming traffic. The vehicle entered the opposite eastbound lane into traffic and struck an 18-wheeler, driven by Theodore Dalton Wells, 56 years, of Austin. Mr. Coy was pronounced deceased on the scene. Mr. Wells sustained minor injuries and was transported to Seton Williamson County Medical Center.

This is the first fatal collision in Taylor for this year. It is not anticipated that any criminal charges will be filed. The investigation into this fatal collision continues.
