Do I Need a Permit for My Home Project?

Check with the City of Taylor before beginning home improvement projects. Permits are often required for home improvement projects, including electrical, mechanical, structural or plumbing work. As a result of getting a permit, an inspector will check the work. Inspections provide a measure of safety to protect your life and property.

Projects That Require Permits

- Re-roofing
- Installing electrical outlets
- Replacing windows
- Remodeling kitchens or bathrooms
- Installing a pool, spa or hot tub
- Building an addition, including patios, decks or pergolas
- Installing appliances and replacements such as furnaces, boilers, water heaters, fireplaces and space heaters
- Building a fence over 6 feet high
- Building a car port
- Building a storage shed over 200 sq. ft.

If you are planning to make home improvements, contact the Building Division at the City of Taylor to find out if you need a permit.
