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Taylor to be Recognized as a Certified Scenic City

The City of Taylor was advised today that it has been selected and will be publicly recognized as a Certified Scenic City at a special reception at the Texas Municipal League's annual conference in Houston this October 2, 2014.

"This is a coveted award and one we are proud to receive," said Interim City Manager Jeff Straub. "The award is based on standards that protect our trees and public spaces, including parks and trails. The City's Planning and Development Department ensures signage, landscaping and sidewalk development requirements are met. Altogether, we are proud of the Scenic City recognition."

The mission of the Scenic City Certification Program is to support and recognize municipalities that implement high-quality scenic standards for public roadways and public spaces, with the long-term goal of improving the image of all cities.
