Introductory

The first edition of the Taylor City Directory is presented to the citizens of Taylor and to the stranger within her gates with the assurance that the work of compilation has been carefully and conscientiously done, under the personal direction and supervision of the publisher, E. F. McComas. In no line of work is experience more necessary than in directory work, and long years of work in advertising and experience in the compilation of directories have brought to the publisher capability which has been exercised to the fullest extent in the preparation of this volume.

It is not possible to produce anything perfect, but the data has been gathered and arranged with utmost care, and the assurance is given that every precaution has been used to avoid errors, and this book is as accurate in detail, and as complete, as it is possible for a work of this description to be. Every house in the city has been personally canvassed, every place of business visited and re-visited, every name checked and re-checked each day, and then, finally, after all general work was done, there was a careful revision, in order that final corrections might be made, and all errors, so far as possible, eliminated.

The City Directory is a book in which each citizen is represented and interested. Persons in every neighborhood, and the strangers in the city use it each day as it comes. Its value as a business factor is generally acknowledged, and its use is much more common than it was a few years ago. A complete and authentic directory is invaluable in business, because it furnishes a simple means of communication. This directory contains the names of all adult citizens of Taylor, with their occupation, place of business, and

A classified Business Directory of all persons engaged in any and all lines of business in Taylor, is to be found in the last part of this book. This section is a great convenience as a purchaser's guide, and will be used to advantage by the residents of the surrounding country, who look to this city for supplies, as well as by citizens of Taylor.

Population

The estimate of population from a Directory is of much interest, and is generally regarded as being nearly correct. There are represented in this volume 1,653 families, which, allowing the regular standard of four to a family, give the population of Taylor approximately 6,612 at the present time.

Historial

THE CITY OF TAYLOR.

The town of Taylor, or Taylorsville, as it was then called, was laid out in 1876, the first lots being sold in June of that year. The first business houses were two general merchandise stores established by C. P. Vance & Co., and Wiley & Porter, respectively. The former was

on the corner of Main and Third streets, where Hyman Melasky's Drug Store now is; the latter occupied the site just north of R. H. Talley & Co's store. Soon after this stores were opened by Womack & Sturgis, and also by Jack Melasky. Dr. John Threadgill put up the first drug store. The First National Bank was chartered in 1883, with C. H. Welch, cashier.

The I. & G. N. opened its office in Taylor July 1876. The M. K. & T. reached here in 1882.

The pioneer newspaper was the TAYLORSVILLE TIMES, established by Minor H. Brown in 1878.

Among the early settlers were H. Dixon, C. H. Welch, Sam Tomlinson, C. L. Fowzer, J. A. Simons, George Pierce, C. Mendel, and Dr. J. S. Brown.

Taylor was incorporated in 1882, with Hon. Daniel Moody as mayor.

Taylor has two trunk lines of railroad, a coffee roasting plant (wholesale), with a daily capacity of 10,000 pounds, a first class mattress factory, whose products are sold all over the South, two cotton seed oil mills, a large compress, a newly built cold storage plant, two ice factories, a good water-works system, a modern sewerage system, a good fire department, to which has just been added the latest improved chemical engine, a \$35,000 City Hall, opera house, substantial brick churches, palatial homes, one of the best public school system in the state, miles of cement sidewalks, electric light plant, large flour mills, railroad division point, and shops in course of construction

which, when completed, will give a pay-roll every thirty days amounting to \$50,000.

In 1907, Taylor received 32,000 bales of wagon cotton.

THE TAYLOR PUBLIC SCHOOL.

The first school was taught by Prof Aten and his wife in 1877. Then came Prof. John McMurray in 1878. In 1880 a public free school was opened. The present system of city schools was organized in 1883, with A E Hill as Superintendent. He was assisted in the first year by J S Jones and Miss Emma Puckett.

The city purchased the school buildings which had been erected by a stock company in 1880. These buildings, together with additions made to them, were used until 1890, when the three-story brick building now occupied by the schools was built.

Prof. Hill remained at the head of the schools continuously from their establishment till June, 1899, at which

time he resigned to engage in other business, and W M Williams, Principal of the High School, was elected Superintendent, which position he held until his resignation in 1908. The present incumbent, Jno F O'Shea, succeeded Mr. Williams, and was re-elected in 1909.

Mr. O'Shea is an able educator, and has an efficient corps of teachers to assist him in the work of public education.

Miss Orra Root has been with the schools continuously for seventeen years; Miss Mary Nunn for fourteen; and Miss Pricilla Draper for ten. Miss Margaret Angus and Mrs. Ida Gentry Davis, who were out for short intervals, have taught for twelve and eight years, respectively. And other teachers have been with the schools for several years. Indeed, for the most part, it has been the policy of the board to employ only experienced teachers, who have been professionally trained, and to keep them as long as they wished to remain. This plan has placed the schools on the high plane they now occupy.
