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CITY OF TAYLOR TO HOST CITYWIDE FALL CLEAN UP OCTOBER 20

Two Locations Designated for Drop Off of Unwanted Items

TAYLOR, Texas –The City of Taylor will once again host a citywide Fall Clean Up on October 20 to give citizens the opportunity to drop off unwanted items that are otherwise too bulky to dispose of. Collections will be at two locations, 1200 Welch St. and 1424 N. Main St., from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The citywide clean up gives Taylor citizens the opportunity to drop off unwanted items including trash, debris and bulky pieces. This service is provided free of charge to Taylor residents and proof of residency will be required.

While most unwanted items will be accepted, there are a few items that the City cannot accept. These include: appliances with refrigerant, batteries, chemicals, hazardous materials, paint, solvents, tires, waste oil, roofing shingles or concrete.
