### **1. INTRODUCTION/PURPOSE**

The Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 2.133 requires specific information established by this chapter be collected, analyzed and reported annually to the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement and the local governmental body.

### **2. DESCRIPTION/ JUSTIFICATION**

Racial profiling is defined as a law-enforcement initiated action based on an individual's race, ethnicity, or national origin rather than on the individual's behavior or on information identifying the individual as having engaged in criminal activity.

The objective is to insure that racial profiling is not occurring by reviewing stops conducted by our officers, review of arrests and review of all searches. Recordings of police interaction are retained by our agency. Complaints regarding police conduct are looked into.

In 2016, we received no complaints of racial profiling. After conducting a review and analysis of these traffic stops, cases and searches in 2016 there is no indication that racial profiling has occurred within the Taylor Police Department. In addition, the number and percentage of traffic stops are consistent with the racial and ethnic demographics of the City of Taylor as measured by the 2010 U.S. Census.
